King Felipe visits the Telefónica stand at MWC



Barcelona, 3 March 2026. – His Majesty King Felipe visited Telefónica's stand at the 2026 Mobile World Congress (MWC), which began today in Barcelona. He was welcomed by Marc Murtra, Executive Chairman of Telefónica; Carlos Ocaña, Vice-Chairman of the company; and Emilio Gayo, COO of Telefónica.

During his visit, King Felipe toured the technological demonstrations that Telefónica is exhibiting at its stand. In the almost 1,000 square metres of its exhibition space, the company is showcasing different technological experiences that highlight the high capabilities of 5G in combination with the utilities of quantum computing, the IoT, Artificial Intelligence, Network Slicing, satellite connectivity, Fog Computing, drones and robots, framed by a 360° LED ring, 15 metres in diameter, suspended and visible.
