Ms. Rotondo has a degree in Economics and Business Administration from the Complutense University of Madrid. She has received complementary training at various Institutions such as ESG Academy/Foretica, IESE, IC-A, EEC, IMD, NYU, Harvard, Boston College, among others.

Since 2016 Ms. Rotondo is a member of ie University's Advisory Board and is currently Co-Director and professor in the Executive Sustainability Programme, where she teaches classes on corporate governance and sustainability. In addition, Ms. Rotondo teaches at BME since 2014, in the Master Investor Relations. She is also a lecturer in various forums and continues with her coaching/mentoring activities.
